- To understand the important symbolic role of flags in local and British history



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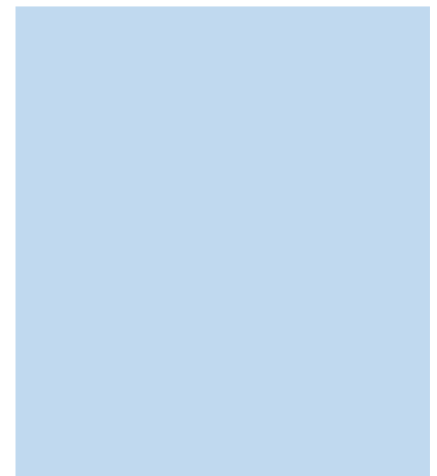
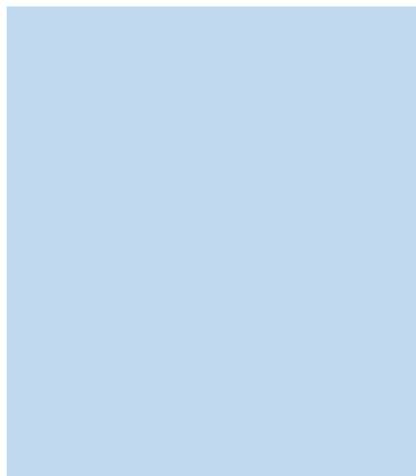
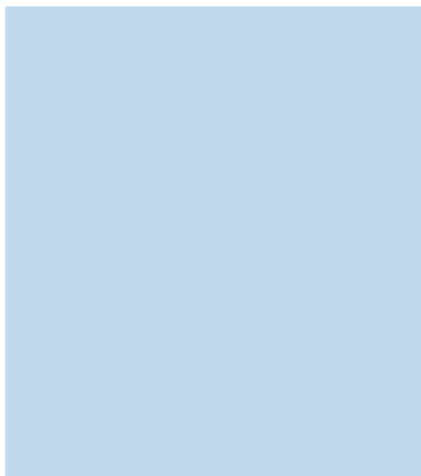


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Activity One

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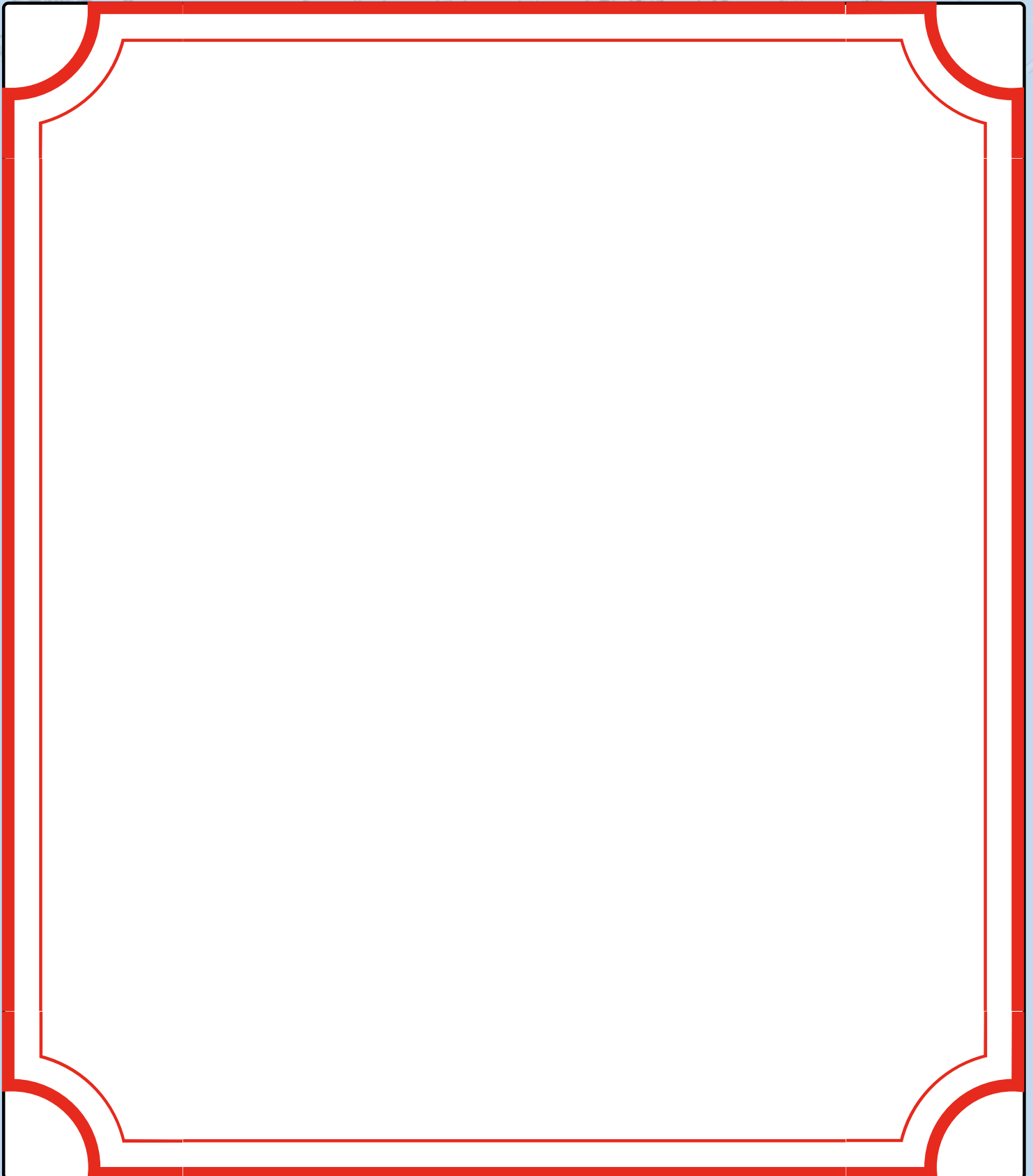


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Extension Activity: Get artistic!
