The dates for each event are given. You must arrange them into chronological order on the timeline.

Add in these important dates from the incredible life of the LV50 Lightship!



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LV-50 is bought by the Royal Northumberland Yacht club and converted into their club house. (1952)

Stationed at 'Seven Stones', protecting ships from the reef near the Isles of Scilly.
(1879 – 1886)

While stationed at 'Calshot Spur', a ship collides with LV50. After this the light-vessel is decommissioned.
(1952)

Moved to the 'Warner' station, off the coast of Southampton.
(1935)

'Friends of LV50' launch the virtual tour of the vessel.
(2021)

Stationed at 'Outer Gabbard' and 'Nore Gallagher'.
(1909 – 1934)

Assisted in guiding the ships during the D-Day landings, carrying soldiers to Normandy, France.
(1944)

LV50 Built by Trinity house and launched.
(1879)

LV50 is added to the National Register of Historic Vessels.
(2000)

Stationed at 'Shambles'.
(1891-1908)
